MEMORANDUM FROM THE CONNECTIONS II PROGRAM OFFICE

SUBJECT: CAP ON THE ASSOCIATED GOVERNMENT FEE (AGF)

The Associated Government Fee (AGF) (also referred to in the GMM tool as the Contract Access Fee (CAF)) reimburses GSA for the cost of developing and operating the contract vehicle and enables federal customers the ability to leverage the flexible streamlined processes, acquisition expertise and responsive service that the Connections II Program provides.

In accordance with the Connections II contract section G.5.2, the Connections II Program Office has instituted a cap on the AGF collected on large-scale orders awarded against any of the 21 Connections II contracts. For all orders, direct or assisted, the following applies:

The AGF is capped at \$150,000 per year per order. [Applies to orders in excess of \$10M/year.]

The 'year' refers to the order year, not the fiscal year.
