JACK BROOKS FEDERAL BUILDING - U.S. POST OFFICE AND COURTHOUSE  
BEAUMONT, TX  
PTX-0019-BE22**

**RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE  
UNITED STATES SENATE**

that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, appropriations are authorized for a repair and alteration project for the Jack Brooks Federal Building, U.S. Post Office and Courthouse (FB-PO-CT) at 300 Willow Street, Beaumont, TX, to address the building's deteriorating envelope and mitigate the impact of humid climate, modernize outdated systems, preserve historic attributes, repair damaged portions of the interior, and undertake site and life-safety improvements at a design cost of \$4,753,000, an estimated construction cost of \$49,630,000, and a management and inspection cost of \$2,822,000 for an estimated total project cost of \$57,205,000, a prospectus for which is attached to and included in this resolution.

*Provided*, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

*Provided further*, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
