**RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF
THE UNITED STATES SENATE**

that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, appropriations are authorized for repairs and alterations to the Federal Building portion of the Prince Jonah Kuhio Kalanianaole (PJKK) Federal Building and U.S. Courthouse complex located at 300 Ala Moana Boulevard in Honolulu, HI, for mechanical and electrical upgrades, restroom upgrades, and fire and life-safety systems replacement, at a design cost of \$4,115,000, an estimated construction cost of \$37,429,000, and a management and inspection cost of \$2,820,000, for an estimated total project cost of \$44,364,000,.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
