ALTERATION MAJOR GENERAL EMMETT J. BEAN FEDERAL CENTER INDIANAPOLIS, IN PIN-1703-IN22

RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE

that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, additional appropriations are authorized for a repair and alteration project for the Major General Emmett J. Bean Federal Center located at 8899 E. 56th Street, Indianapolis, IN, to complete critical repairs and upgrades to the building's exterior, including to window systems, replace the building's cooling tower and correct the resulting ongoing water infiltration, and to repair the interior at an additional estimated construction cost of \$2,107,000 for an estimated total project cost of \$47,439,000, a prospectus for which is attached to and included in this resolution. This resolution amends the authorization of the Committee on July 1, 2020, of Prospectus No. PIN-1703-IN21 to account for cost escalations due to time and market conditions.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
