**RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE
UNITED STATES SENATE**

that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, additional appropriations are authorized for a repair and alteration project for the Joseph F. Weis, Jr. U.S. Courthouse (Weis Courthouse) located at 700 Grant Street, Pittsburgh, PA, to replace the heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) system, associated electrical systems, a section of the roof, and to provide lightning protection and a fall arrest system at an additional total cost of \$3,114,000, a prospectus for which is attached to and included in this resolution. This resolution amends the authorization of the Committee on September 30, 2020, of Prospectus No. PPA-0158-PI20 to account for refined scope and cost escalations due to time and market conditions.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
