that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus providing for a repair and alterations project for the Daniel Patrick Moynihan U.S. Courthouse, located at 500 Pearl Street, New York, NY, at an estimated design cost of \$3,812,000, estimated construction cost of \$43,905,000, and estimated management and inspection cost of \$2,723,000, for a total cost of \$50,440,000, a prospectus for which is attached hereto and included in this resolution, is approved.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
