COMMITTEE RESOLUTION

ALTERATION ENERGY AND WATER RETROFIT AND CONSERVATION MEASURES PROGRAM VARIOUS BUILDINGS PEW-0001-MU23

Resolved by the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the U.S. House of Representatives, that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, appropriations are authorized to implement projects that directly result in reduced energy usage, reduced water usage, utility costs savings and reduced pollution and emissions in Government-owned buildings beginning in fiscal year 2023 at a total cost of \$15,000,000, a prospectus for which is attached to and included in this resolution.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any agency the authority granted by this resolution.

Provided further, not later than 30 calendar days after the date on which a request from the Chair or Ranking Member of the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Representatives is received by the Administrator of the General Services, the Administrator shall provide such Member a response in writing that provides any information requested regarding the program.

Provided, that the Administrator of General Services shall aim to achieve net zero carbon buildings, if determined by the Administrator to be practical and cost-effective.
