ALTERATION JUDICIAL CAPITAL SECURITY PROGRAM VARIOUS BUILDINGS PJCS-0001-MU23

RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF THE UNITED STATES SENATE

that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus providing for alterations to improve physical security in buildings under the jurisdiction, custody, and control of the General Services Administration (GSA) occupied by the Federal judiciary and the Department of Justice, U.S. Marshals Service (USMS), during Fiscal Year 2023 to improve separation of circulation for the public, judges, and prisoners to address elements such as adding doors, reconfiguring, or adding corridors, reconfiguring or adding elevators and sallyports, and constructing physical or visual barriers at a total cost of \$20,000,000, a prospectus for which is attached to and included in this resolution, is approved.

Provided, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
