McGee Avenue, at reduced design cost of \$1,355,000, an additional estimated construction cost of \$63,786,000, and additional management and inspection cost of \$3,243,000 for an additional estimated project cost of \$65,674,000.a description of which is attached hereto and by reference made part of this resolution, is approved.
