COMMITTEE RESOLUTION

**ALTERATION
FEDERAL BUILDING AND U.S. COURTHOUSE
PADUCAH, KY
PKY-0059-PA24**

Resolved by the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the United States House of Representatives, that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. § 3307, appropriations are authorized for the repair and alteration project for the Federal Building & U.S. Courthouse (FBCT) located at 501 Broadway Street, Paducah, Kentucky, to address security deficiencies for the U.S. Courts (Courts) and U.S. Marshals Service (USMS), and addresses the needs and conditions of the FBCT by completing a full building system and infrastructure modernization and a full seismic upgrade to the building at a design cost of \$3,324,000, estimated construction cost of \$34,485,000, and management and inspection cost of \$2,670,000, for a total estimated project cost of \$40,479,000, a prospectus for which is attached to and included in this resolution.

Provided further, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any agency the authority granted by this resolution.

Provided further, not later than 30 calendar days after the date on which a request from the Chair or Ranking Member of the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Representatives is received by the Administrator of the General Services, the Administrator shall provide such Member a response in writing that provides any information requested regarding the program.
