B. STANDARD CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

The following standard conditions and requirements shall apply to any premises offered for lease to the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA (hereinafter called the GOVERNMENT):

Space offered must be in a quality building of sound and substantial construction, either a new, modern building or one that has undergone restoration or rehabilitation for the intended use.

The Lessor shall provide a valid Occupancy Permit for the intended use of the Government and shall maintain and operate the building in conformance with all applicable current (as of the date of this solicitation) codes and ordinances.
