hereinafter called the Lessor, and the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter called the Government:

WITNESSETH: The parties hereto for the considerations hereinafter mentioned, covenant and agree as follows:

1. The Lessor hereby leases to the Government the following described premises:

A total of 1,776 Rentable Square Feet (RSF) of contiguous office and related space, consisting of 1,586 ANSI/BOMA Office Area Square Feet (ABOASF) to be located on the 1st floor of the building known as Wingate, 4900 Koger Blvd., Greensboro, NC 27407-2736, in addition to four (4) surface parking spaces.

to be used for SUCH PURPOSES AS DETERMINED BY THE GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION

- 2. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises with their appurtenances for the term of ten (10) years, five (5) year firm term, years beginning <u>Year 1</u> through <u>Year 10</u>, subject to termination and renewal rights as may be hereafter set forth.
- 3. The Government shall pay the Lessor annual rent for the entire term, monthly, in arrears, as follows:

- Note 1. The rate per rentable square foot (RSF) is determined by dividing the total annual rental by the rentable square footage set forth in Paragraph 1 above.
- Note 2. The rate per ABOASF is determined by dividing the total annual rental by the ABOASF set forth in Paragraph 9.
- 4. The Government may terminate this lease, in whole or in part, at any time on or after the 5th year, by giving the Lessor at least one hundred and twenty (120) days notice in writing. No rent shall accrue after the effective date of termination. Said notice shall be computed commencing with the day after the date of mailing.
- 5.—This lease may be renewed at the option of the Government, for the following terms and at the following rentale:

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provided notice be given in writing to the Lessor at least _____days before the end of the original lease term or any renewal term; all other terms and conditions of this lease shall remain the same during any renewal term. Said notice shall be computed commencing with the day after the date of mailing.

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6. Rental is subject to the Government's measurement of plans submitted by the Lessor or a mutual on-site measurement of the space and will be based on the rate per ABOASF as noted in Paragraph 3 above, in accordance with Clause 27 (PAYMENT), GSA Form 3517B, General Clauses. The lease contract and the amount of rent will be adjusted accordingly, but not to exceed the maximum ABOASF requested in SFO Paragraph 1.1 (Amount and Type of Space). Rent for a lesser period shall be prorated. Rent checks shall be made payable to:

- 7. The Lessor shall furnish to the Government, as part of the rental consideration, the following:
 - A. Those tenant improvements, facilities, services, supplies, utilities, and maintenance in accordance with Solicitation for Offers (SFO) No. 8NC2034.
 - B. Buildout in accordance with Solicitation for Offers 8NC2034. Construction Drawings (CDs) shall be prepared by the Lessor and due to the Government within twenty (20) working days subsequent to receipt of Government prepared and approved Design Intent Drawings (DIDs). All tenant alterations are to be completed within one hundred and twenty (120) working days of receiving notice to proceed from the Government with agency approved working/construction drawings. Lease term to be effective and rental to begin on date of occupancy, if different from Paragraph 2.
 - C. Lessor shall provide four (4) surface parking spaces, at no additional cost to the Government.

- The premises described in Paragraph 1 of this Standard Form 2 shall contain 1,586 ABOASF of office and related space, as identified in SFO 8NC2034.
- 10. The rental rate in Paragraph 3 for the period of Year 1 through Year 5 includes all Tenant Improvements. In accordance with Paragraph 3.2 of SFO 8NC2034, the Tenant Improvement allowance (T/I) provided in the lease is \$34.09 per ABOASF, or a total of \$54,066.74 amortized at an interest rate of 6% over five (5) years yielding an annual cost of \$12,543.14 at a rate of \$7.91 per ABOASF (\$7.06 per RSF). The T/I will be used to construct the interior space in accordance with the approved Design Intent Drawings. If the T/I cost exceeds \$34.09 per ABOASF (for up to 1,586 ABOASF), the balance due the Lessor will be paid by rental adjustment or lump sum, to be determined by the Government. If the entire tenant improvement allowance of \$34.09 per ABOASF is not used, the Government will adjust the rental rate downward to off-set the difference in the T/I. The Lessor understands, in lieu of Cost and Pricing Data, his contractor or each of his sub-contractors shall solicit three (3) bids for work completed as a part of the initial tenant alterations, e.g., for electrical, plumbing, etc. The lowest responsive bid will be accepted. This does not apply to the shell build-out. 9. Lessor agrees that should the Government vacate the premises after the fifth year, the Government is not responsible for any unamortized unpaid T/I.
- 11. In accordance with Paragraph 1.12 (Building Shell Requirements) of SFO No. 8NC2034, the annual shell rent for Year 1 through Year 10 is established as \$21,317.96 yielding \$13.44 per ABOASF (\$12.00 per RSF) which is inclusive of the rental rate in Paragraph 3.
- 12. In accordance with Paragraph 4.2 (Tax Adjustment) of SFO No. 8NC2034, the percentage of Government occupancy is established as 2% (based on total building area of 89,478 RSF and the Government's occupancy of approximately 1,776 RSF). Percentage of occupancy is subject to revision based on actual measurement of Government occupied space at time of final inspection, not to exceed the maximum ABOASF stated in the SFO, and in accordance with GSA Form 3517B, GENERAL CLAUSES.
- 13. In accordance with Paragraphs 4.3 (Operating Costs) of SFO No. 8NC2034, the annual operating rent is established as \$8,709.62 yielding an escalation base of \$5.49 per ABOASF (\$4.91 per RSF) which is inclusive of the rental rate in Paragraph 3 for the period of Year 1 through Year 10.
- 14. In accordance with Paragraph 4.1 (Measurement of Space) of SFO No. 8NC2034, the common area factor (CAF) is established as 12% or 1.12, based on 1,776 RSF and 1,586 ABOASF.

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- 15. In accordance with Paragraph 5.14 (Waiver of Restoration) of SFO No. 8NC2034, the Lessor hereby waives all restoration rights.
- 16. In accordance with Paragraph 4.6, (Overtime Usage) of SFO No. 8NC2034, the hourly overtime usage for the entire space is established as \$6.00 per hour, per floor.
- 18. Any deviation from approved construction plans or tenant alterations require approval by the Contracting Officer or Contracting Officer's Designee. Should Lessor make changes without approval the Government will not be responsible for the cost of those changes and Lessor will not be reimbursed.
- 19. All fire and life-safety deficiencies must be corrected prior to occupancy and at no extra cost to the Government, including but not limited to the following as required by SFO No. 8NC2034.
 - A. Provision of emergency illumination in corridors, stairways and office space.
 - B. Provision of exit lights in corridors.
 - C. Provision of (2) exits on each floor occupied by the Government.
 - D. Provision of a fire extinguisher near every exit.
- 20. All handicapped accessibility deficiencies must be corrected prior to occupancy and at no extra cost to the Government, including but not limited to the following as required by SFO No. 8NC2034.
 - A. Door Entrances.
 - B. Exit Doors.
 - C. Parking Areas/Curb Cuts.
 - D. Restrooms.
 - E. Width of Exit Doors.
- 21. Within five (5) days of lease occupancy, the Lessor shall provide the tenant agency representative (with a copy forwarded to the GSA Government Representative), on site, a copy of the name and phone number of maintenance personnel in order that any cleaning, maintenance, janitorial, etc. problems can be rectified immediately.
- 22. In accordance with SFO 8NC2034 Paragraph 2.3 Broker Commission and Commission Credit, Jones Lang LaSalle ("Broker") is the authorized real estate broker representing GSA in connection with this lease transaction. The total amount of the Commission is and is earned upon lease execution, payable according to the Commission Agreement signed between two parties. Due to the Commission Credit described in SFO 8NC2034 Paragraph 2.3, only which is the "Commission Credit" which is the "Commission Credit"

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to be credited to the shell rental portion of the annual rental payments due and owing to fully recapture this Commission credit. The reduction in shell rent shall commence with the first month of the rental payments and continue until the credit has been fully recaptured in equal monthly installments over the shortest period practical.

Notwithstanding Paragraph 3 of this Standard Form 2 of this Lease, the shell rental payments due and owing under this lease shall be reduced to fully recapture this Commission Credit. The reduction in shell rent shall commence with the first month of the rental payments and continue as indicated in this schedule for adjusted Monthly Rent:
