SECTION 1 THE PREMISES, RENT, AND OTHER TERMS

1.01 THE PREMISES

The Premises are described as follows:

Office and Related Space: 1,872 rentable square feet (RSF), yielding 1,872 ANSI/BOMA Office Area (ABOA) square feet of office and related space (based upon a Common Area Factor of 1 percent, located on the 1st floor of the Building, as depicted on the floor plan(s) attached hereto as Exhibit A. The governments percentage of occupancy for this lease is 100% of the building.

1.02 EXPRESS APPURTENANT RIGHTS

The Government shall have the non-exclusive right to the use of Appurtenant Areas, and shall have the right to post Government Rules and Regulations within such areas. The Government will coordinate with the Lessor to ensure signage is consistent with the Lessor's standards. Appurtenant to the Premises and included with the Lease are rights to use the following:

A. Parking: Parking spaces as depicted on the plan attached hereto as Exhibit A of which 2 shall be surface parking spaces. In addition, the Lessor shall provide such additional parking spaces as required by the applicable code of the local government entity having jurisdiction over the Property.

B. Antennae, Satellite Dishes and Related Transmission Devices: Space located on the roof of the Building sufficient in size for the installation and placement of the telecommunications equipment as such may be described herein, together with the right to access the roof and use of, all building areas (e.g., chases, plenums) necessary for the use, operation, and maintenance of such equipment at all times during the term of this Lease.

1.03 RENT AND OTHER CONSIDERATION

A. The Government shall pay the Lessor annual rent payable monthly in arrears at the following rates:

B. If the Government occupies the Premises for less than a full calendar month, then rent shall be prorated based on the actual number of days of occupancy for that month.

C. Rent shall be paid to the Lessor by electronic funds transfer in accordance with the provisions of the General Clauses. Rent shall be payable to the Payee designated in the Lessor's Central Contractor Registration.

D. The Lessor shall provide to the Government, in exchange for the payment of rental and other specified consideration, the following:

1. The leasehold interest in the Property described in "Paragraph 1.01 THE PREMISES" created herein;
2. All costs, expenses and fees to perform the work required for acceptance of the Premises in accordance with this Lease, including all costs for labor, materials, and equipment, professional fees, contractor fees, attorney fees, permit fees, inspection fees, and similar such fees, and all related expenses;
3. Performance or satisfaction of all other obligations set forth in this Lease; and
4. All services, utilities, and maintenance required for the proper operation of the Property, the Building, and the Premises in accordance with the terms of the Lease, including, but not limited to, all inspections, modifications, repairs, replacements, and improvements required to be made thereto to meet the requirements of this Lease.

1.04 TERMINATION RIGHTS

The Government reserves the right to terminate this Lease, in whole or in part, at anytime during the term of this lease with 60 days' written notice to the Lessor if (i) regularly scheduled commercial air services ceases, (ii) the airport opts to replace █ screeners with private contractors, (iii) the checkpoint supported by the leased space is closed, or (iv) Government reduces its presence at airport due to a reduction in deplanements. The effective date of the termination shall be the day following the expiration of the required notice period or the termination date set forth in the notice, whichever is later. No rental shall accrue after the effective date of termination.

1.06 RATE FOR ADJUSTMENT FOR VACANT LEASED PREMISES

In accordance with the section entitled "Adjustment for Vacant Premises" if the Government fails to occupy or vacates the entire or any portion of the Leased Premises prior to expiration of the term of the Lease, the operating costs paid by the Government as part of the rent shall be reduced by \$7.15 per ABOA sq. ft. of space vacated by the Government.

SECTION 2 GENERAL TERMS, CONDITIONS AND STANDARDS

2.01 DEFINITIONS AND GENERAL TERMS (APR 2011)

Unless otherwise specifically noted, all terms and conditions set forth in this Lease shall be interpreted by reference to the following definitions, standards, and formulas:

- A. Appurtenant Areas. Appurtenant Areas are defined as those areas and facilities on the Property that are not located within the Premises, but for which rights are expressly granted under this Lease, or for which rights to use are reasonably necessary or reasonably anticipated with respect to the Government's enjoyment of the Premises and Express Appurtenant Rights.
- B. Days. All references to days in this Lease shall be understood to mean calendar days.
- C. FAR/GSAR. All references to the FAR shall be understood to mean the Federal Acquisition Regulation, codified at 48 CFR Chapter 1. All references to the GSAR shall be understood to mean the GSA supplement to the FAR, codified at 48 CFR Chapter 5.
- D. Firm Term/Non-Firm Term. The Firm Term is that part of the Lease term that is not subject to termination rights. The Non-Firm Term is that part of the Lease term following the end of the Firm Term.
- E. Lease Term Commencement Date. The Lease Term Commencement Date means the date on which the lease term commences.
- F. Lease Award Date. The Lease Award Date means the date that the Lease is signed by the LCO (and on which the Lessor's obligations under the Lease commence).
- G. The Premises. The Premises are defined as the total Office Area or other type of Space, together with all associated Common Areas, described in Section I of this Lease, and delineated by plan on Exhibit X. Parking and other areas to which the Government has rights under this Lease are not included in the Premises.
- H. The Property and the Building. The Property is defined as the land and buildings in which the Premises are located, including all appurtenant areas (e.g., parking areas to which the Government is granted rights). The building(s) situated on the Property in which the Premises are located shall be referred to herein as "the Building(s)."
- I. The Space. The Space shall refer to that part of the Premises to which the Government has exclusive use, such as Office Area, or other type of Space. Parking areas to which the Government has rights under this Lease are not included in the Space.
- J. Standard for Measuring Office Area and Other Space. For the purposes of this Lease, Space shall be measured in accordance with the standard provided by American National Standards Institute/Building Owners and Managers Association (ANSI/BOMA) for Office Area. ANSI/BOMA Z65.1-1996 shall be used. References to ABOA mean ANSI/BOMA Office Area.

2.02 AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES (APR 2011)

The signatories to this Lease shall have full authority to bind their respective principles with regard to all matters relating to this Lease. No other persons shall be understood to have any authority to bind their respective principles, except to the extent that such authority may be explicitly delegated by notice to the other party, or to the extent that such authority is transferred by succession of interest. The Government shall have the right to substitute its Lease Contracting Officer (LCO) without notice or an express delegation by the prior LCO. GSA assumes no financial responsibility for any cost incurred by the Lessor except as provided by the terms of the lease agreement or authorized in writing by the LCO.

2.03 WAIVER OF RESTORATION (APR 2011)

The Lessor shall have no right to require the Government to restore the Premises upon termination of the Lease, and waives all claims against the Government for waste, damages, or restoration arising from or related to (a) the Government's normal and customary use of the Premises during the
